H I S T O R Y U N F O L D I N G

MAY 14, 1948 – THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE STATE OF ISRAEL

- ▶ 1909, the first collective community in Israel (a Kibbutz) was established between the Sea of Galilee and the Jordan River.
- ▶ 3.3 million people have immigrated to Israel since 1948.
- ▶ 1.5 million of these came from Russia (the north).
- ▶ 44% of them have come since 1990.
- ▶ 6.7 million Jews live in Israel today.
- ▶ Millions more are prophesied to come

GLOBAL RECOGNITION OF MILITARY STRENGTH

- ▶ Israel is the 8th most powerful country in the world,¹ with the 18th most powerful military worldwide,² and the most technologically advanced military on Earth.³

GROWING COMMUNITY OF JEWISH BELIEVERS IN JESUS (YESHUA)

- In a 2017 report on International Religious Freedoms, the US Department of State revealed that, according to the community, there are approximately 20,000 Jewish Believers in the Israeli, Golan Heights, West Bank, and Gaza areas.

AN INCREASE OF INTERCESSORS FOR ISRAEL

- In 1984 there were twenty-five 24/7 houses of prayer around the world. Today there are over twenty thousand, and the majority of them are praying for Israel.

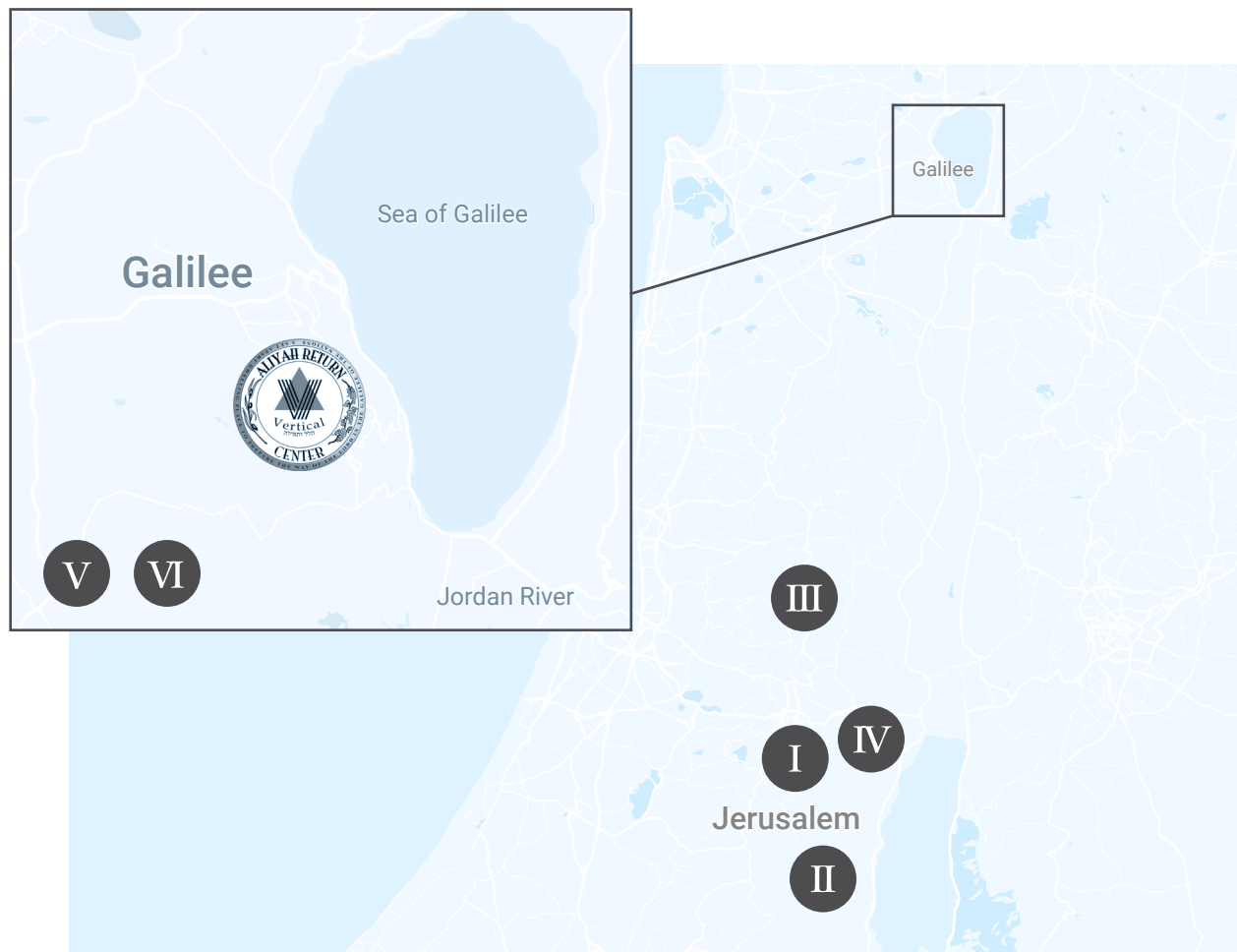

► Ezekiel 40-48 describes in detail the plans for the future Temple that will be rebuilt in the land of Israel.

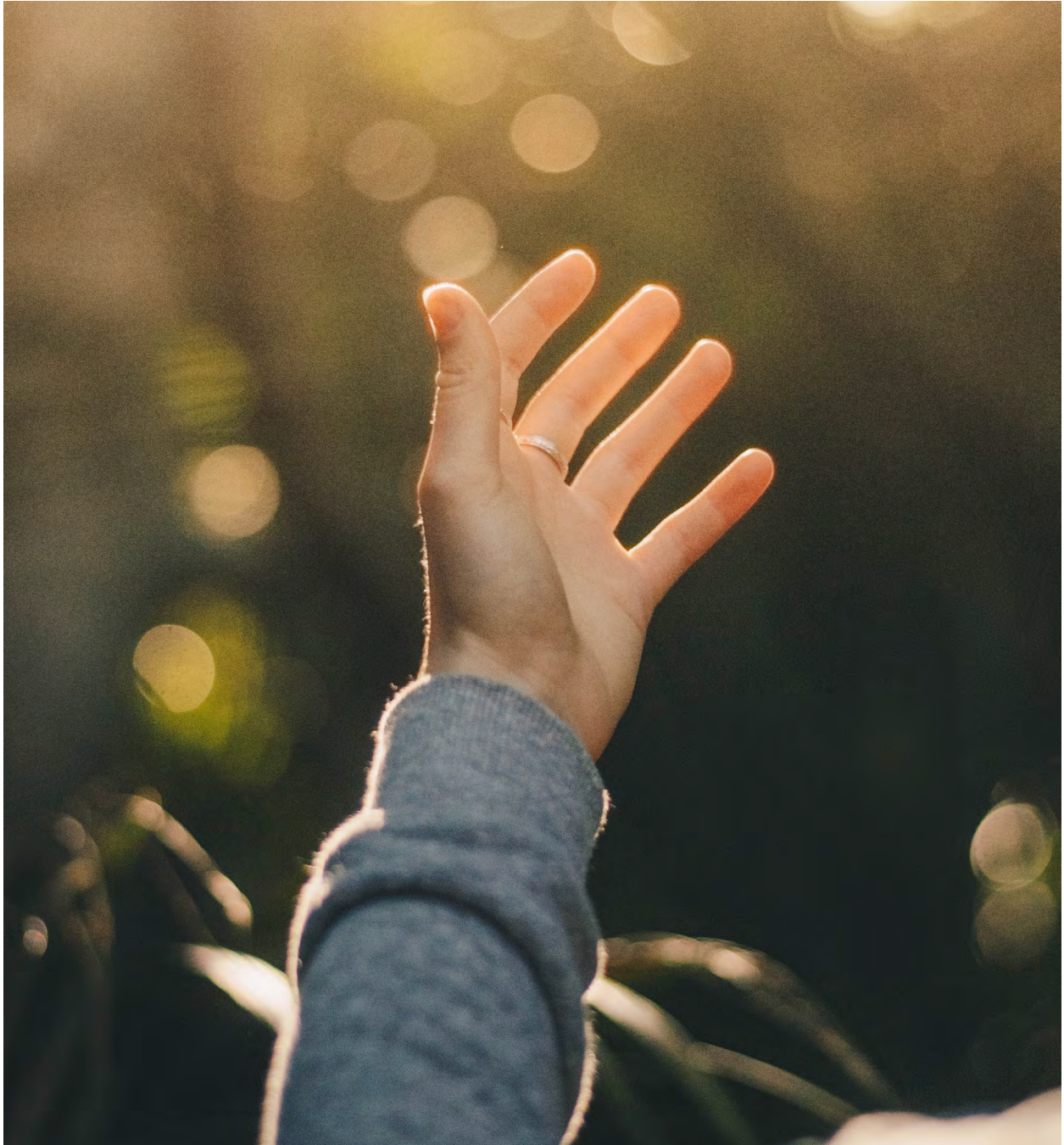



Refuge and Transformation for Aliyah Immigrants

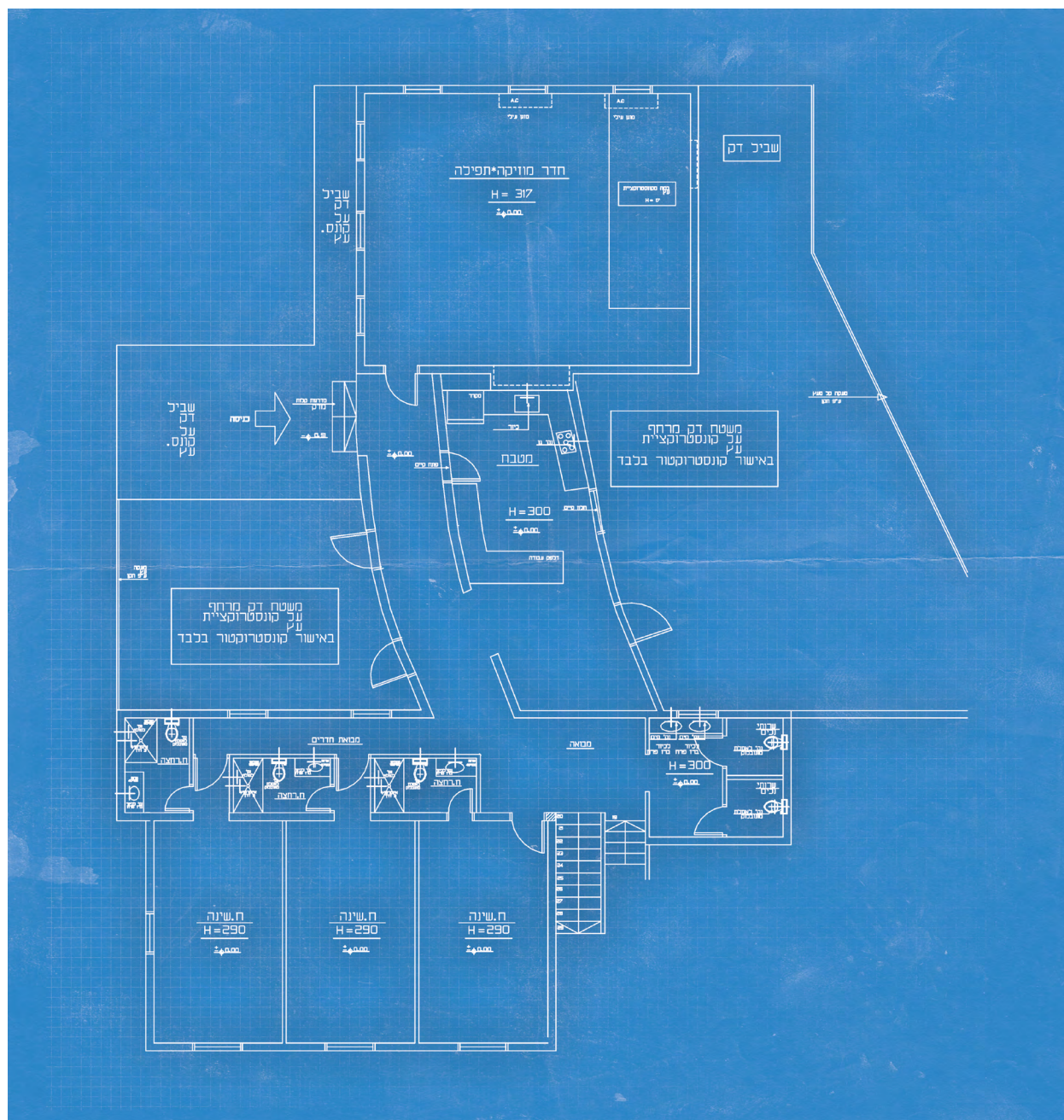


The Aliyah Return Center has been a refuge to thousands of immigrants in need over the past several years and is currently constructing the Vertical Galilee House of Prayer


